Ministry **Architectural Advisor**

What does it involve? To provide expert advice (including written reports) on the liturgical implications of proposals being considered by the Finance, Asset and Risk Management Committee as required. In response to requests from the Finance Committee Chairman; to provide costed options appraisals for alterations to the architectural form to enhance the liturgy. To advise the Committee as required on appropriate architectural practices from whom fee quotes might be procured and the basis of fee quotes relative to the RIBA Stages. To liaise with architectural practices and planning authorities if required.

Gifts required:

- Good understanding of post Vatican II liturgy and its architectural requirements.
- Well-organised (and, at times, able to work to tight timelines)
- Ability to work collaboratively with others in the parish
- Ideally RIBA and/or RTPI member.

Time required (average weekly/monthly) up to 4 -8 hours monthly on specific projects with no time input at other times)

Special peaks in time commitments likely: When specific projects being considered

How long would I need to commit for? Ideally, 3 years with an opportunity to review the role after 6 months
