Requirements of ministry **Flower arrangers**

What does it involve? To enhance experience of the liturgy through flower displays. To liaise with those providing temporary art and décor to ensure no clashes occur and work collaboratively in teams or singly. Potentially, work on special services, e.g. funerals, baptisms and marriages as required by the Parish Priest or those involved in the preparation of these Sacraments.

Gifts required:

- Creative with a good sense of colour and a “way” with flowers and plants
- Understanding of and respect for the place of colour and plants in the liturgical calendar
- An understanding of (or willingness to learn) of the liturgical seasons and colours
- Good team player and ability to work collaboratively

Time required (average weekly/monthly) 2 hours monthly (as part of a rota)

Likely peaks in time commitments: Easter, Pentecost, Christmas,

How long would I need to commit for? Ideally, 3 years with an opportunity to review the role after 6 months

Location: Home/church

Responsible to: Liturgy Leader

Other key relationships: Architectural Adviser, Sacristans

Support available: Adult education courses, other arrangers

DBS check required: Unlikely – Safeguarding Officer to confirm
